

Great orders for local firm

MALAGA-based company RF Innovations has won a \$1 million contract to supply paging transmitters for the Victorian Government's Emergency Alerting System (EAS).

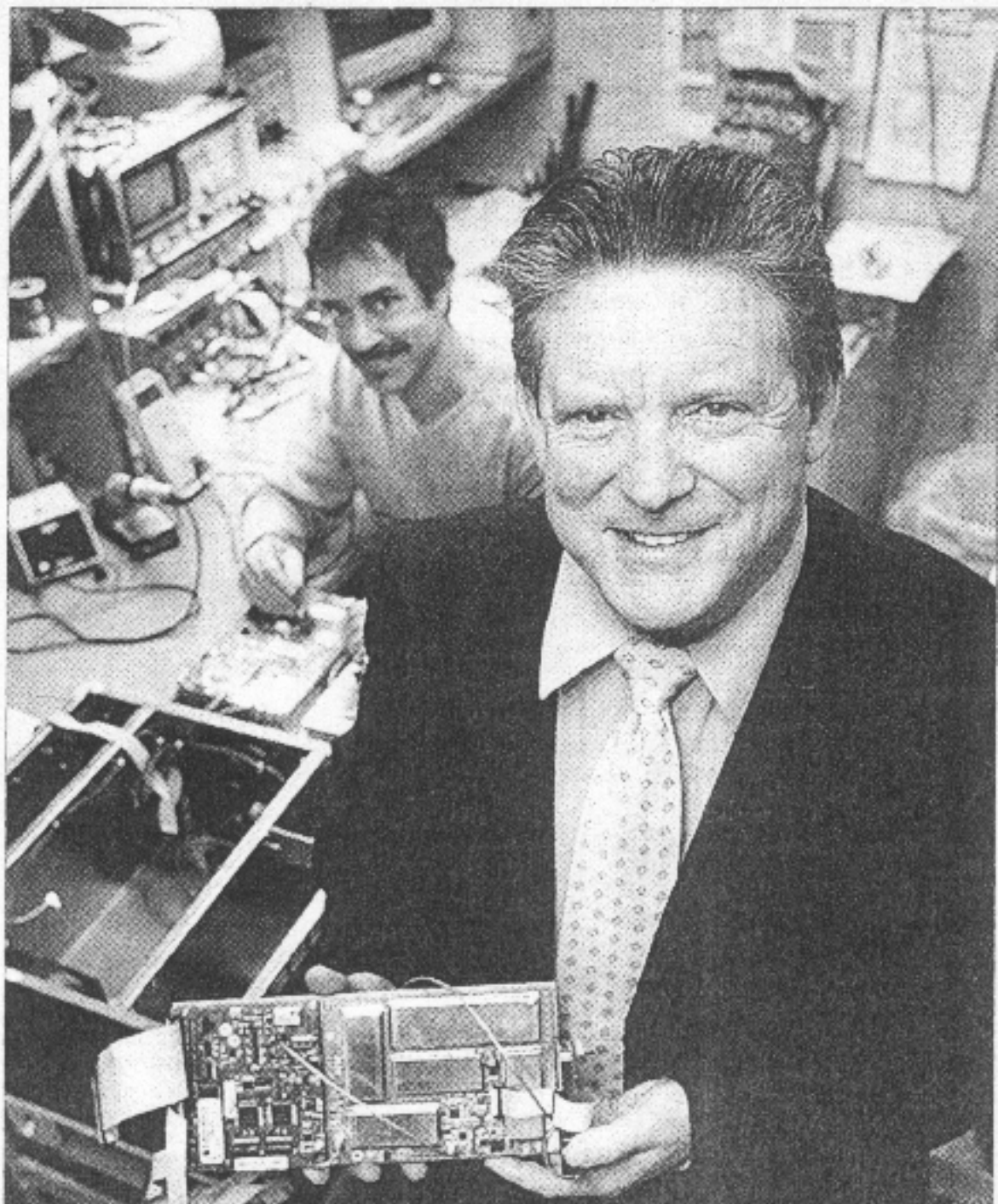
Managing director Richard Wilkins said the EAS would improve response times by emergency services personnel.

The contract win follows a recent order for RF Innovation's paging transmitters by the Saudi Arabian electricity supply authority and 500 transmitters for a major European network.

"A growth market for paging has emerged because of the need for reliable blanket messaging in emergency conditions such as terrorist attacks, where normal telephone systems can become overloaded," Mr Wilkins said.

"RF Innovations has received forward orders exceeding \$5 million for advanced wireless data products and system development contracts.

"As a result of the company's growth, increasing profitability, and the expressions of interest in our patented technology, the directors are positioning RF Innovators for a future public listing."
